## Digitus Cleaning / Disinfecting Recommendations

Digitus recommends regular cleaning of all touch surfaces of its products including:

- Nexus Head Units
- Cabinet Handles
- Desktop Fingerprint Scanners
- Card Readers

### Items you will need

- Rubbing alcohol containing 70% Isopropyl alcohol
- A clean non-abrasive lens wipe grade cloth (this is important as fingerprint surfaces can be scratched)

### Cleaning Instructions

- Moisten the lens wipe grade cloth with an appropriate amount of rubbing alcohol
- Gently clean all exposed surfaces including fingerprint sensors

#### Cautions

- Be sure to read and use the caution instructions for the rubbing alcohol you have purchased
- Take care not to get rubbing alcohol inside the product, you are only cleaning / disinfecting the external surfaces
- If you are unsure the rubbing alcohol is suitable, please contact Digitus for approval before using it
- Do not apply rubbing alcohol directly to the surface of the product
- Do not use any form of abrasive cleaner or cloth to any surfaces
